Holiday Vaccinations

Are you going on holiday this year? You might need vaccinations if you're going outside the UK to prevent serious diseases in other parts of the world. If you are unsure about vaccinations make an appointment with one of our practice nurses.

Hay Fever

Many people suffer with hay fever during the summer which can be unpleasant. Hay fever is caused by grass pollen which makes you sneeze, gives you itchy eyes and makes your nose run similar to cold/flu symptoms. If you suffer with this you could seek advice from a pharmacist as treatments are available over the counter. If no improvement make an appointment with the GP.

Fun in the sun

Everyone loves to have fun when the weather is nice but it is crucial that you remember to be safe whilst having fun. You may not feel like it is too hot but any amount of sun can damage your skin. Here are some tips for you:

- ◆ Always use sun screen when the weather is hot. Never use less than SPF 15
- ◆ Always drink plenty of water to stop you from becoming dehydrated.
- ◆ Children have a greatly increased risk in the sun so make sure they are always topped up every couple of hours.
- Wearing a hat will help to keep you cool and stop your head from getting burnt.
- ◆ Do not stay in the sun all day, this will increase your risk of sun stroke and can become serious.

Pharmacy First

Are you entitled to free prescriptions? Then you may be entitled to pharmacy first. This scheme offers advice and treatment for many minor ailments. Free treatment is available for minor ailments such as: bites & stings, chicken pox, colds, colic, conjunctivitis, diarrhoea, eczema, hay fever, head lice and so much more. Just ask at our reception desk for a leaflet on pharmacy first which will include what it's all about, if you are entitled to this service and what ailments they deal with.
